THE FACTS

Project Information

OC San will rehabilitate two parallel sewers on north and southbound Seal Beach Blvd./ Los Alamitos Blvd., and along Katella Avenue, Oak Street, and Lexington Drive in the cities of Seal Beach and Los Alamitos. The work consists of removing calcium buildup at various pipe joints and injecting chemical grout to strengthen the pipe. Rehabilitation and/or replacement of over 70 manholes will also take place.

Potential Impacts

- Night work and occasional weekend work
- Noise and dust
- Occasional turn restrictions
- Lane closures
- Crosswalk closures
- Street parking restrictions
- Bus stop relocation

OC San is closely coordinating with the cities and mitigating potential impacts. As work is scheduled in your neighborhood, notices will be distributed with specific details.
