Location: Seal Beach Blvd. from Rossmoor Center Way to Bradbury Rd. in Seal Beach

Construction Activity – Nighttime


Construction work is starting on southbound Seal Beach Blvd. in Seal Beach. There are two manholes between Rossmoor Center Way to Bradbury Rd. that need to be replaced. Each manhole replacement will take approximately 3 weeks to complete before moving on to the next one. The work will be done at night when sewer flows are low. Final street restoration will take place once all work is completed.

Schedule: Mid-February – End of March 2023

 - Additional manhole work on Seal Beach Blvd. (as shown on the map) will take place following this activity.

Area of Work
